

Project evaluation: The successful story of ILECUs III



Initial Situation

An important milestone related to the Austrian commitment in the Western Balkan countries and in Southeastern Europe is the establishment of the International Law Enforcement Coordination Units (ILECUs). In the context of the previously completed EU projects ILECUs und DET-ILECUs II the Criminal Intelligence Service Austria (.BK) initiated the creation of a network comprising eight national units and their heads of ILECU*s*.

Consequently the .BK commissioned milestone p.o.e. ag with the evaluation of the ILECU*s* III Project regarding relevance and adequacy, effect, effectiveness (achievement of objectives and aims), efficiency, sustainability and quality of the project management process.

Goal setting

According to the .BK, the international law enforcement units should boost the effectiveness and efficiency of organized cross-border crime control in Western Balkan countries.

In this context, the cross-border information exchange processes need to be enhanced and the judicial and police reactions centralized and harmonized in each ILECU country.

A monitoring process of these measures in terms of duration and quality will be conducted in accordance with Western standards.
